#### **Family to Family Support:**

CHA will develop, adopt and implement identified goals within the annual campus improvement plan targeting family engagement.

CHA will develop and support leadership skills for family members and provide opportunities for families to advocate for their children/families.

CHA will collaborate with families to develop strategies to solve problems and be problem solvers.

CHA will engage families in shaping program activities and cultivating that reflect two-way communication.

CHA will provide families with an opportunity to review and provide input on programs, communications and events in order to ensure the program is responsive to the needs of families.

CHA will use tools such as surveys or focus groups to gather family feedback on the family engagement plan.

#### **Equip Families with Tools to Enhance Learning:**

CHA will design or implement home educational resources to support learning at home while strengthening the family/school partnership.

CHA will equip families with resources and skills to support their children through the transition to school and offer opportunities for families and children to visit the school in advance of the prekindergarten school year.

CHA will provide families with information, best practices and training related to age-appropriate developmental expectations.

CHA will collaborate with families to appropriately respond to children's behaviors in a non-punitive, positive and supportive way.

CHA will provide essential professional development for educators in understanding engagement with families.

CHA will develop staff skills to support and use culturally diverse, culturally relevant and culturally responsive family engagement strategies.
