### Literacy: Early Childhood Campus Plan

- To Increase student literacy performance, K-3rd grade teachers will:
- Have a shared vision of what high-quality literacy instruction looks like
- Attend professional development and use knowledge gained in the classroom
- Complete purposeful and intentional internalization of units and lessons in curriculum
- Support the belief that every child deserves a champion
- Use literacy assessments to diagnose unfinished instructions
- Participate in vertical alignment discussions to understand how curriculum builds from one grade to the next
- Collaborate with teammates to support each other through the learning process
- Participate in peer observations to support a strong instructional community
- Support and nurture learners to increase their skills and love as readers and writers

#### EARLY CHILDHOOD LITERACY BOARD OUTCOME GOAL

 The percentage of all 3rd Graders that score MEETS or above on STAAR reading will go from 29% in Spring of 2022 to 60% in Spring of 2027.

To Increase student math performance, K-3rd grade teachers will:

- Plan collaboratively each week by reviewing formative assessment data, student work samples, and curriculum documents;
- Differentiated math strategies are incorporated into lessons to close the achievement gap for subpopulations;
- Attend professional learning sessions to support math instruction to boost student learning through the Region 11-"All Aboard", Family Math and Science Night, and ongoing school-wide professional development.

#### EARLY CHILDHOOD MATH BOARD OUTCOME GOAL

 The percentage of all 3rd Graders that score MEETS or above on STAAR math will go from 41% in Spring of 2022 to 60% in Spring of 2027.
